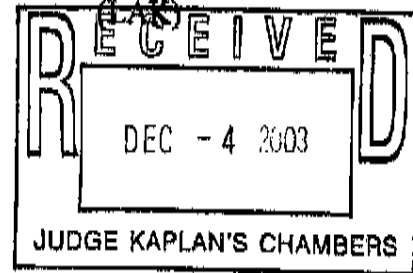

**STIPULATION AND ORDER**

WHEREAS the Settlement Agreements entered into between the parties in the above captioned action specified at paragraph 13 that:

While the Second Notice will include a date by which Proof of Claim Forms should be returned, which will be not less than 120 days from the mailing of the Second Notice, the parties agree that for the purposes of the Settlement, distributions from the Settlement Fund to Sellers will be made against all validly executed Proofs of Claim received, regardless of whether they are received within the 120 day period so long as they are received prior to June 7, 2006 ("Late Seller Claims");

WHEREAS the Second Notice specified that claim forms must be returned to the Settlement Administrator "postmarked no later than December 10, 2003;"

WHEREAS the Court modified the Order And Final Judgment entered in this case to require that any extensions by the parties of the time to carry out any provisions of the Stipulation must be based on further order of the Court;

WHEREAS the parties have been notified that a postal strike materially adversely affected mail service and delivery for several weeks in November, 2003, particularly in and around the London area;

WHEREAS problems with mail service in Europe, particularly in England, are likely to be significantly further exacerbated over the course of December, in light of the substantial increase in postal service demand imposed due to the holidays;

WHEREAS the parties have been contacted by class members regarding delays in the receipt of necessary claims forms and other claims related documentation, and their concern for being able to meet the Court imposed December 10, 2003 deadline for timely filing of valid Proof of Claim Forms;

WHEREAS the parties stipulate and agree that the deadline for receipt of Proof of Claim Forms by the Claims Administrator should be extended until January 15, 2004;

WHEREAS the parties further stipulate and agree that the notification of this extension should be provided to class members generally through the website and the help line, and that in addition, Christie's and Sotheby's London offices should be notified of the extension, and should so advise any class members who contact them;

IT IS THEREFOR SO ORDERED that:


1. The deadline for receipt of Proof of Claim Forms by the Claims Administrator is hereby extended until January 15, 2004.

2. Notification of this extension will be provided to class members generally through the website and the help line. In addition, Christie's and Sotheby's London offices will be notified about the extension, so that they can provide information about the extension to class members who contact them about the deadline.
